Antídoto is located in the province of Soria, in perhaps the coolest microclimate of the Ribera del Duero. The resulting wines are considerably fresher and more elegant than is typical from the appellation. Hernando and Sourdais farm their own vineyards with no artificial fertilizers, herbicides, or pesticides, and they work with like-minded growers for the balance of their fruit.
